- BTEC Level 2 Art and Design Merit level or a related vocational area

COURSE DETAILS

BTEC Level 3 Certificate in Art consists of one mandatory unit plus two optional units that provide for a combined total of 30 credits and 180 guided-learning hours. It is broadly equivalent to one GCE AS –Level.

BTEC Level 3 Subsidiary Diploma in Art consists of four mandatory units plus two optional units that provide for a combined total of 60 credits and 360 guided-learning hours. It is broadly equivalent to one GCE A-Level.

Visual Recording in Art and Design, Materials, Techniques and Processes in Art and Design, Ideas and Concepts in Art and Design, Communication Through Art and Design.
