SPECIFIC ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

- Students must achieve a minimum of 5 GCSEs Grade A* – C including English and Mathematics
- Grade B (Higher Tier) in GCSE Chemistry or Grade B (Higher Tier) in Core and Additional Science
- Satisfactory level of competence in English
- Grade B in Mathematics

COURSE DETAILS:

The A Level syllabus has been overhauled in line with government policy for first teaching in 2015. You will study 6 modules of work each covering different key concepts of chemistry. Assessment is now all at the end of the 2 year course and consists of three written exam papers. Practical work is assessed throughout the course, providing evidence for a Practical Endorsement.
