WHY ENGLISH LANG LIT?

The course in English Language and Literature offers students the opportunity to study integrated linguistic and literary approaches to English. It is a very good progression from either GCSE Language or GCSE Literature. Students will be given opportunities to study spoken English and media texts in greater depth as well as developing their skills in analysing and comparing prose and drama texts.

AGCE courses in English Language and Literature complement other Sixth Form courses and are designed to encourage wider reading and develop understanding of language frameworks. The course encourages students to take analytical and creative approaches to English, and involves an element of adaptive writing for which students re write texts for a different purpose and audience.
