## **SPECIFIC ENTRY REQUIREMENTS**

- Students must achieve a minimum of 4 GCSEs Grade A\*- C plus English Language and Mathematics at Grade 4
- Grade 6 in GCSE English Literature

## COURSE DETAILS

You will study two units as follows:

**Component 1** - Drama and Poetry Pre-1900 – Shakespeare, drama and poetry pre-1900 (2 hours 30 minutes exam- 40%)

**Component 2** - Comparative and contextual study – American Literature 1880 -1940, The Gothic, Dystopia, Women in Literature, The Immigrant Experience (2 hours 30 minutes exam- 40%)

Component 3 - Literature Post 1900 (3000 word coursework -20%)
