The A Level course builds on the knowledge, understanding and skills gained at GCSE. Students will enhance their linguistic skills and develop their capacity for critical thinking, develop their ability to interact effectively with users of the language in speech and in writing, engage critically with intellectually stimulating texts, films and other materials in French, develop knowledge about matters central to the society and culture, foster their ability to learn other languages and equip themselves with transferable skills such as autonomy and creativity that will enable them to proceed to further study or to employment.
