Certificate = 2 mandatory units - 1 externally marked controlled assessment, Extended Certificate = 4 units - 3 mandatory units (1 written exam) plus 1 optional unit, Foundation Diploma=6 units - 4 mandatory units (1 written exam) plus 2 optional units.

Mandatory Units: Information Technology Systems (Written Exam), Creating Systems to Manage Information.

Optional Units: Using Social Media in Business, Programming, Data Modelling, Website Development and Computer Games Development.
