Students begin their Geography GCSE in year 9. They study the AQA course. A series of skills modules are taught first before moving onto the specific physical and human content of the course.

A Level students follow the AQA course. The current content options in year 1 are Water & Carbon Cycle, Hazards and Changing Places. Fieldwork is conducted in school time and as a residential. Year 2 consists of Coasts, Contemporary Urban Environments and coursework.
