

Section 3 – Develop the skills you'll need at university



On-line course to help you prepare

Studying at uni or college can be different to how you're used to studying at Thomas Telford. Get a head start by brushing up on the skills you'll need now, so you're fully prepared when the time comes.

The University of East Anglia has developed a 6 week on-line course (3 hours per week) to help you explore and develop key analytical skills that you will need in order to succeed at university learning environment.
