Dear Parent/Carer

As you may now be aware, Madeley Academy has set up a Year 6 Transition tab on our website to keep you informed and updated on proceedings in the lead up to September.

You should have already received a letter from the Academy confirming the cancellation of the scheduled Transition days and Induction Evening due to Government guidance. Included in that letter, you should have found a number of forms that the Academy requires you to return in the stamped addressed envelope. If you have not received these forms, or if they have been misplaced, copies have been added to the Year 6 Transition Tab for your convenience.

With the cancellation of the Transition days, we have alternatively been filming an introductory video and online virtual tour of the Academy which will go live on the Year 6 Transition Tab in the coming weeks. Please continue to check the Academy website for these updates.

We are also working hard to ensure that all students are placed in appropriate teaching groups and are assigned a Personal Tutor. Once this has been completed, the information will be shared with you via the post. Please expect a phone call from your personal tutor in early July to introduce themselves to you, and to be a point of contact if you have any queries or concerns.

With regard to September, we are still finalising the first day arrangements and are currently waiting on further advice from the Government before we share anything that could be confusing or conflicting. It is our intention to use the first day back as a transition day to secondary school. At this point in time we expect that uniform for the first part of the term will be PE kit. The Academy PE kit is compulsory for all students and can be purchased from Baker and Sons in Wellington. Further information on PE kit will follow in due course.
