KS5

Learners should be able to explore, research and acquire techniques and develop their skills, knowledge and understanding in a range of Fine Art media. Learners should explore relevant images, artefacts and resources relating to Fine Art. Learners may use traditonal methods and/or digital techniques to produce Fine Art work. Learners in Fine Art are expected to demonstrate specialisaton in partcular materials, media or processes to allow for an appropriate depth of study. This can be achieved by working toward the extension and development of partcular themes, ideas or issues. Drawing skills should be understood and developed as appropriate to the ways of recording and communicating intentons, ideas and emotons in the context of Fine Art.
