A Teacher of Mathematics is required. The successful candidate will work under the direction of the Head of Mathematics and Assistant Headteacher as part of a team dedicated to improving standards, achievement and the continued development of the Mathematics programme within the Academy.

Experience Required

It will be essential for the successful candidate to hold Qualified Teacher Status and preferably a degree. It would also be an advantage to have had experience teaching Mathematics to the full ability range to GCSE level. Experience of teaching Mathematics at A Level would be an advantage, but is not essential. We welcome applications from newly qualified teachers.

Personal Qualities

It will be vital to be able to relate positively to young people, enjoy their company and be able to communicate effectively (avoiding confrontation). You will also need to be resilient, have a capacity for hard work, and be equipped to manage challenging children. This post is suitable for experienced teachers and NQTs.

We are looking for an enthusiastic person who will fit into the team and enjoy the prospect of continuing to raise standards in teaching and learning.

A high level of confidence will be needed to engage children and to utilise active learning approaches to the teaching of Mathematics.

A positive outlook with regard to working with children and a commitment to the Academy's child-centred ethos is essential.

Mathematics

Mathematics at Madeley Academy is housed in a dedicated Maths Block of 8 rooms (teaching) and an intervention room. All teaching rooms have PCs installed with interactive whiteboard technology. Other equipment is readily available. A variety of software is also available for use with this technology and is being constantly added to.

The **Key Stage 3** curriculum is delivered at specific levels for each group, and the Mathematics department has enjoyed continuous improvements in Key Stage 3 process year on year.

At **Key Stage 4** students take the OCR Foundation or Edexcel Higher course. Key Stage 4 results continue to improve year on year.

At **Key Stage 5** students follow the AQA curriculum taking modules C1, C2 and S1 in the Lower Sixth Form, and C3, C4 and S2 in the Upper Sixth Form.

We are now looking for a teacher who will motivate and inspire the students and continue to raise standards generally.
